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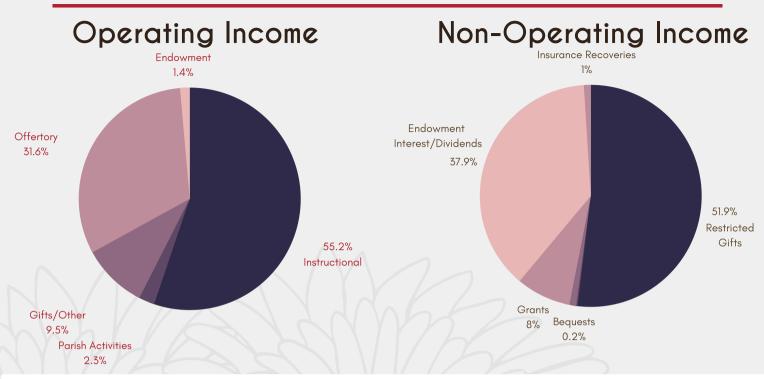

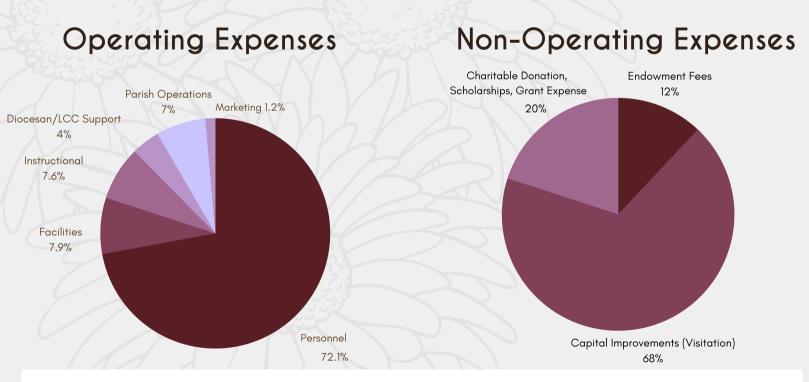
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ALLOCATION OF FUNDS



INCOME

Fiscal year 2019-2020 was greatly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. There are two areas to note. The 35.3% increase in our "Other Collections" (or offertory on the pie chart) is from our twice yearly Visitation. And the 60.5% decrease in "Gifts/Donations" (Gifts/Other) was from a large bequest in '18-19. The Parish Subsidy to the school was greatly increase due to the impact of COVID-19.



EXPENSES

Expenses in 2019-2020 overall were down compared to prior year, a silver lining of the COVID-19 pandemic. You will see a notable increase in our "Administrative/Office" Expenses which is the result of reclassifying a previously misclassed expense. The Diocesan Assessment expense was down compared to PY as the Diocese forgave all the parishes last quarter payments to assist with COVID-19 impacts.

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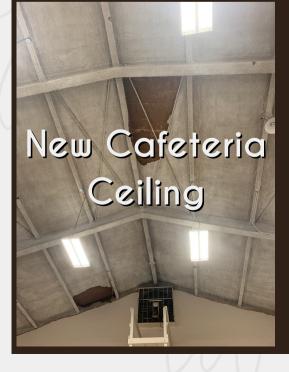
