#### **HIGHLIGHTED POINTS OF INTEREST**

As we look back on the past fiscal year we recognize that the time to return back to normal can take longer than expected. For this reason, there can still be some variances in comparison to the prior year.

On the operational side (top portion), you will notice an increase in our student services revenue such as cafeteria and extended day which were greatly reduced in the first part of the pandemic. You will also see a large dip in the "Gift and Donationns" . Most of this dip is attributable to the PPP loan forgiveness that was received in the prior fiscal year ending June 2021

On the operational expense side you will notice many of our parish activities have resumed along with student services. Most other expenses have remained steady or even decreased.

For the non-operating activity (bottom portion), the greatest change was in the investment losses from our endowment which are subject to market volatility. We did, however, see more than a doubling of new gifts, such as donations to our endowment.

As we continue to rebuild our community with Living Stones we can be extremely grateful for the generosity of all who have contributed time, talent, and treasures this past year. Their gifts insure that our ministries continue at St. Charles and our mission is upheld.
